

Can the power storage cabinet be placed in the car in winter





Overview

Whenever possible, indoor storage is the best option for your car during winter. Air up the tires before winter car storage (don't exceed the maximum inflation) and if possible, park the vehicle on squares of two-inch foam board insulation. This will help lessen the chance that the tires will develop flat spots from sitting for months. Tires will lose air over time, so don't. The average car battery loses 30-50% of its power when temperatures drop below freezing, making proper storage not just smart—it's essential. Temperature Shock: For every 20°F drop in temperature, a car battery loses about 25% of its capacity. At 32°F, your battery operates at roughly half its. When preparing your vehicle for winter it is important to choose a location where your vehicle will not be affected by the elements. Choosing an indoor dry space, with concrete floors is the prime option. Parking the vehicle in your own personal garage or renting a storage unit to keep the vehicle. 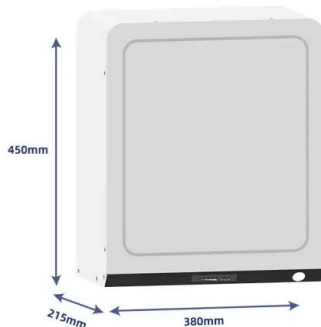
