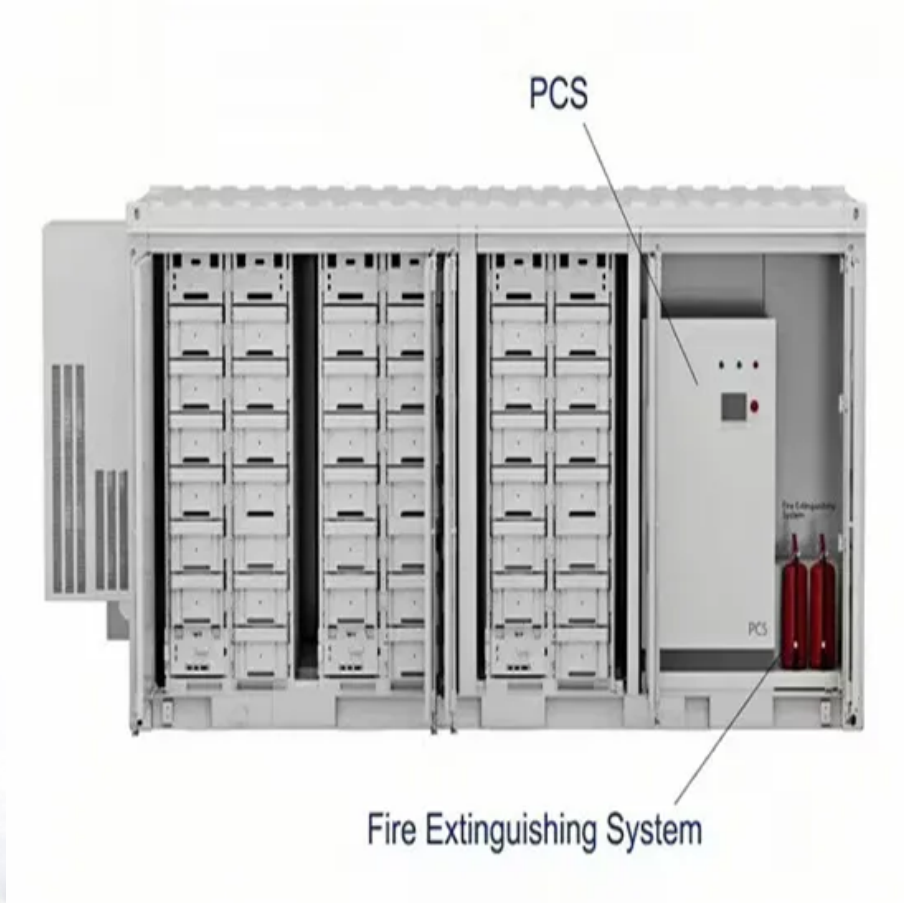


Embedded energy equipment board prohibits solar container integration enterprises





Overview

The demand restrictions are intended to inhibit companies with ties to Chinese entities—which is defined by assessing executive and board structure, debt and equity holders, IP holders, and principal place of business—from monetizing the production tax credits issued to. New FEOC -- for "foreign entity of concern" -- rules will deny technology-neutral tax credits on new power plants and energy storage projects that use too much Chinese equipment and section 45X tax credits on US-made products that use too many Chinese inputs. They will also deny such tax credits to. Foreign entity of concern (FEOC) rules deny tax credits for projects that exceed using certain thresholds of Chinese products. The One Big, Beautiful Bill Act (OBBBA) includes new restrictions on technology neutral tax credits, including project-based tax credits and the 45X manufacturing tax. FEOC is an acronym meaning "Foreign Entity of Concern" and is the DC way of saying companies that have ties to North Korea, Russia, Iran, or China. Inserting FEOC prohibitions and language in the One Big Beautiful Bill now gives legislatures a vehicle to place future restrictions on companies with. The system will be imported under four model numbers: SBE 125, SBE 250, SBE 500, and SBE 1000, and housed in either a 10-foot or 20-foot container. According to sources cited by Bloomberg, the U.S. Congress has prohibited the Pentagon from procuring batteries produced by six Chinese companies, including CATL and BYD. Additionally, the other four battery manufacturers set to be banned are Envision Energy, EVE Energy, Gotion High-Tech, and. On July 4, 2025, Congress passed the One Big, Beautiful Bill Act (OBBB). The law includes several provisions that may impact cooperatives, including: Direct Pay continued: Maintains the elective payment (Direct Pay) option for solar and energy storage projects. 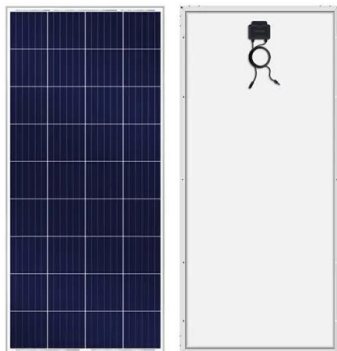
