Overview

Drawing on a collection of international experiences and the revised OECD Guidelines on Corporate Governance of State-Owned Enterprises, this report provides practical implementation guidance on how SOEs and their owners can lead by example on sustainability. It identifies three approaches through which China has progressively deepened its participation: (1) large-scale export of solar products, (2) investment and construction of solar power projects, and (3) offshore investment in local solar manufacturing bases in the Gulf. 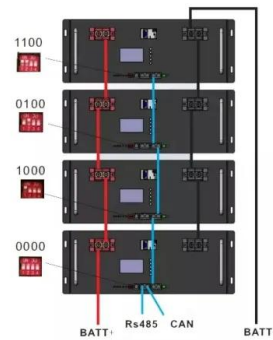

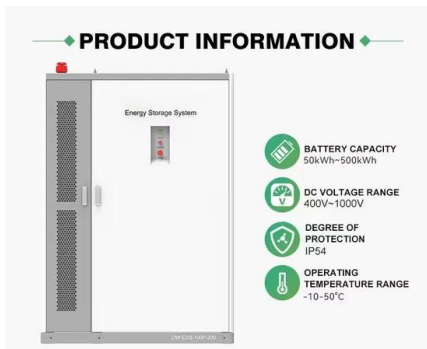
