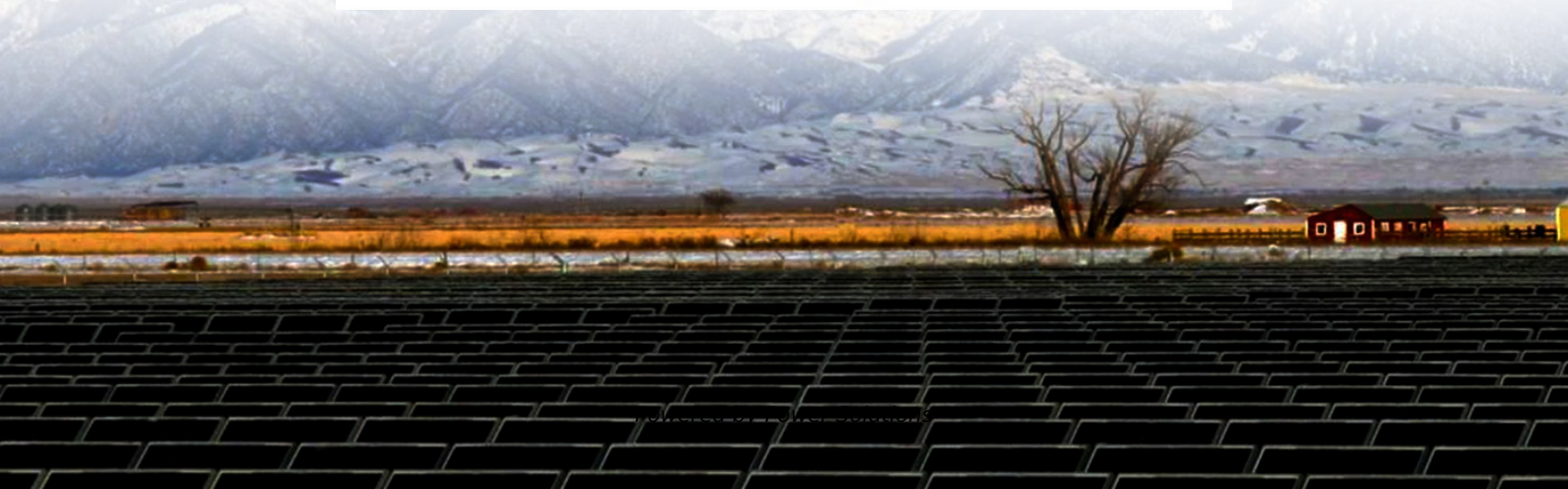

The UK government has published its plan to support solar deployment to 2030 and beyond. 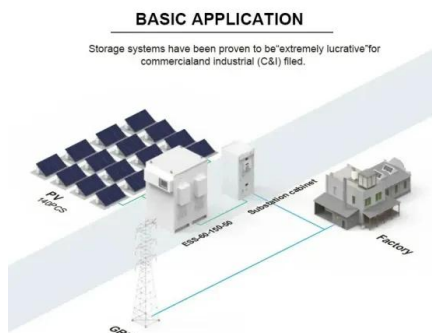
